QUALIFYING FOR LPGA TOUR - SECTION II

ELIGIBILITY: Basic Application Requirements

- 1. Entries are open to professional and amateur golfers who were female at birth.
- Applicants must submit to the LPGA headquarters an LPGA Application for entry accompanied by a processing fee in an amount determined by the LPGA.
- Amateurs must demonstrate that they have an approved and authenticated USGA handicap index of 3.4 or less when making application for the LPGA Qualifying Tournament.
 - *An individual can retain her amateur status throughout the entire qualifying process. In the event the individual obtains status on the LPGA Tour for 2006, the amateur status is forfeited and the individual becomes professional.
- Entries are subject to the eligibility requirements of the LPGA Constitution and are subject to rejection at any time (including during Tournament) by the LPGA. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct.

SCHEDULE

Competition will be in two stages, at stroke play:

1. Sectional Qualifying - 72 holes

Mission Hills Country Club, Palm Springs, California -September 20-23, 2005 Plantation Golf & Country Club, Venice, Florida -October 4-7, 2005

The Top-30 players and ties will be automatically entered in the Tour Qualifying at LPGA INTERNATIONAL, Legends/Champions Courses, November 29 -December 4, 2005. **No further entry fee is required.**

2. Tour Qualifying - 90 holes

LPGA INTERNATIONAL, Legends/Champions Courses, Daytona Beach, Florida
MONDAY, NOVEMBER 28- Registration/Practice Round
TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 29-Practice Round
WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 30 - 1st Round 18 holes
THURSDAY, DECEMBER 1 - 2nd Round, 18 holes
FRIDAY, DECEMBER 2 - 3rd Round, 18 holes
SATURDAY, DECEMBER 3 - 4th Round, 18 holes (field will be cut to the low 70 scores and any tying for 70th place.)
SUNDAY, DECEMBER 4 - Final round, 18 holes (Legends Course)

Purse: A \$50,000 purse will be distributed.

PURPOSE OF COMPETITION

To determine (1) those who will be offered Tournament Division Membership in the Ladies Professional Golf Association with exempt player status for the 2006 Tour season; and (2) a further number who will be offered conditional membership in the LPGA for one season only.

The number of qualifying positions available at the LPGA INTERNATIONAL Qualifying for exempt status will depend solely on the number achieving exempt status through performance as determined by current LPGA Regulations. Thirty five conditional memberships may also be awarded.

A playoff, if necessary, to determine final exempt positions on the 2006 LPGA Tour, will be held as soon as practicable after the conclusion of the final round.

NOTIFICATION

Notification of acceptance into the Qualifying events will be sent within 24 hours from time of receipt, to the mailing address or e-mail address indicated on the application form. The LPGA is not responsible for mail delivery service. It is the applicant's responsibility to contact the LPGA office, at (386) 274-6200, to determine her status.

The LPGA assumes every applicant will participate unless written notice is received at LPGA Headquarters.

No refund of an entry fee will be made unless written notice of withdrawal is received prior to the Qualifying application deadline. Any withdrawal after the application deadline of August 30, 2005 will be subjected to a \$500 service fee.

PUBLICITY RIGHTS

All television, radio, photo, motion picture, internet and similar media rights for players participating in an LPGA tournament, including qualifying school or any portion thereof, shall be granted and assigned to the LPGA by virtue of the entry of any such player into any such event.

All such rights granted and assigned to the LPGA are thereafter the property of and reserved by the LPGA. Any use thereof without its express and written consent is prohibited. Players further agree, by virtue of entering in any such tournament, to refrain from any action which would interfere with the LPGA's ownership of its authorized use of the specified rights.

Such rights may be used by the LPGA for: (a) advertising, promoting or publicizing such events, or any broadcasts thereof, and/or the LPGA or any of its affiliates; (b) live broadcasts during such events; (c) recorded broadcasts or exhibitions as a part of programs or motion pictures of such events; and/or (d) year-end summaries or spots and/or news programs.

INSURANCE

All participants in LPGA Qualifying Tournaments are insured for liability which may arise from participation in Qualifying rounds.

TRANSPORTATION

All entrants are responsible for their own transportation and accommodations at the Qualifying events. Information regarding available commercial accommodations will be forwarded to all entrants upon acceptance of entry.

ENTRIES: Forms and Fees

Entrants shall apply on LPGA forms, obtainable on the web site at www.LPGA.comorfromLPGAHeadquarters, 100 International Golf Drive, Daytona Beach, FL 32124.

A \$3,500 entry fee for one Qualifying Tournament or both Sectional Qualifying Tournaments shall be paid by each applicant. The entry fee will not be refunded unless sickness or grave personal emergency prevents play in the first qualifying event entered by the applicant. In which case, written notice of withdrawal and request for refund must reach the LPGA by the registration deadline together with supportive documents of sickness of grave personal illness for the Qualifying Tournament as noted herein.

The entry fee must be submitted in the form of a **Certified Check** made payable to:

REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

All entrants must either:

- Register in person at the site of the Qualifying Tournament by registration deadline.
- 2. State arrival time directly to the LPGA Tournament Official:
 - a) At LPGA HEADQUARTERS or
 - At Sectional Qualifying Site Palm Springs, Calif., Mission Hills Country Club: Venice, Fla., Plantation Golf & Country Club;

In the absence of such notification, the LPGA will withdraw the player from the Qualifying Tournament. No refund will be made for such withdrawals.

MEETING OF ENTRANTS (Palm Springs Only)

A mandatory meeting for all entrants in the Palm Springs Sectional Qualifying Tournament will be held preceding the Tournament.

An information packet will be distributed at registration.

FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY / CHECK CASHING

No financial services will be provided during Qualifying. All entrants are hereby notified that check cashing services will not be available.

PRACTICE PRIVILEGES

Notice of privileges and requirements will be forwarded to all entrants upon acceptance of entry. Failure to abide by requirements stated will be considered unbecoming conduct and may result in rejection of that player's entry into the Qualifying Tournament. The decision to reject an entry, based on such unbecoming conduct, is solely at the discretion of the LPGA Tournament Official.

CADDIES AND CARTS

Sectional Qualifiers - All contestants must take a cart. Caddies may be employed in addition to the cart. No local caddies will be provided.

Tour Qualifying - Contestants must either provide their own caddie, or carry their own bag. No local caddies or golf carts will be available.

AMERICAN WITH DISABILITIES ACT ACCOMMODATION REQUESTS

The American with Disabilities Act (ADA) affords individuals with disabling conditions the right to access public accommodations. Accessibility arrangements are within the discretion of the LPGA and will be determined by the nature and extent of the disabling condition, subject to guidelines set forth in local, state and federal law. Upon the timely receipt of a completed LPGA Accommodation Request Form, and required documentation, the LPGA will evaluate a request to use a cart in the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament due to a disabling condition on a case-by-base basis.

In order for the LPGA to evaluate an accommodation request, individuals must submit (i) a completed LPGA Accommodation Request Form, (ii) current medical documentation (prepared within the same calendar year as the request), setting forth the exact nature of the disability and how the disability prevents walking during the stipulated round and (iii) information sufficient to enable the LPGA to determine that providing a cart would not provide a player with an advantage over other players. You may obtain a copy of the LPGA Accommodation Request Form by sending a written request and a self-addressed stamped envelope to the LPGA at 100 International Golf Drive, Daytona Beach, Florida 32124, Attention: Legal Department.

THE LPGA ACCOMMODATION REQUEST FORM, AS WELL AS ALL OTHER REQUIRED INFORMATION, MUST BE SUBMITTED PRIOR TO ORTOGETHER WITH THE SUBMISSION OF THE PLAYER'S APPLICA-

TION FORM. The information requested must be submitted to:

Late and/or incomplete requests will not be evaluated.

RULES OF GOLF

Play will be governed by the Rules of Golf as approved by the USGA modified by the LPGA Rules of Play Card and any posted local rules.

Questions shall be settled by the LPGA Rules Committee, whose decision shall be final.

GOLF BALLS

Only brands of golf balls on the USGA's latest list of conforming golf balls may be used.

The "One Ball Rule" - will be in effect.

TIME OF STARTING

The optional condition for time of starting prescribed in Appendix I in the Rules of Golf booklet shall be in effect.

CONDITIONS, SCHEDULES

The LPGA reserves the right to alter any of the conditions and schedules herein. The decision of the LPGA in any matter shall be final.

ORIENTATION OF TOUR QUALIFIERS (MANDATORY)

All contestants awarded 2006 Tour status (**exempt or conditional**) through this Qualifying Tournament who were not on the LPGA Tour in 2003, 2004 or 2005 must attend the **MANDATORY ORIENTATION** meeting Monday, December 5 and Tuesday December 6, 2005. Please plan accordingly when making airline and room reservations. The requirement for playing privileges is that qualifiers attend the **entire meeting.** Futures Tour members that receive exempt status based on the Top-5 finishes from the year end official money list must also attend.
