#### **Nearest airports:**

Melbourne Tullamarine Airport is approximately 50km from the Golf Club – approximately 1 hour drive. Avalon Airport (domestic) is approximately 80km from the Golf Club – approximately 2 hours drive depending on traffic. Note: Courtesy Cars will only pick up from Tullamarine Airport.

#### **Airport Transfers:**

Airport pickup times will depend upon the arrival/departure times you provide to Coco Eke at Golf Australia (Ph: +61401 559 624 Email: [cocoe@golfaustralia.org.au](mailto:cocoe@golfaustralia.org.au)) Players should receive confirmation of their hotel booking direct from their desired hotel and will need to forward this information to Coco Eke at the tournament office.

#### **Conditions:**

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

→ **IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR ALL PLAYERS AND CADDIES – VISA APPLICATIONS**

- It is possible to arrange group visas when travelling to Australia. Players and caddies are advised to ensure their visa requirements are in order **before travelling**.
- It is recommended all players and caddies take out the Sport Visa (subclass 421), and please check the Australian Embassy or their web site for details on how to apply, what information you will need to supply etc.

→ **GOLF CLUBS**

- Australian Customs require all golf clubs entering from International destinations to be clean and free of dirt / mud. To ensure an efficient entry into Australia, please clean all golf clubs.

→ **Transurban CityLink:**

If you are planning on driving yourself around Melbourne, you may need a CityLink Pass. CityLink is an electronic tolling system (no tollbooths) that connects Tullamarine, West Gate and Monash Freeways. It means drivers need a CityLink Pass to travel on these freeways.

*You can choose from:*

- **24 Hour Pass:** Unlimited access for a 24 hour period from your first trip. (approx \$11.30)
- **Tulla Pass:** Unlimited travel between Bulla Road and Flemington Road only, for a 24 hour period from your first trip. (approx \$4.00)

**Weekend Pass:** Unlimited access from midday Friday to midnight Sunday. (approx \$11.30)

- **Internet Facilities:** There will be Wi-Fi facilities in the Hotel and in the Player's Lounge / Locker Room
