## **REGISTRATION**

All players must register for the Final-Qualifying Round at the LGU Championship  
Office at Fairhaven Golf Club **no later than** half an hour before their tee time.

Local Rules and Conditions of Competition for the Championship including the Pace  
of Play procedure will be given to players at registration.

## **PRACTICE**

Official practice is available in 3-balls between 11am and 5pm on Sunday 26th July  
and times may be booked after Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> July by calling the club on +44 (0)1253 736741  
during office hours.

Practice rounds prior to these days are available only at the discretion of the club  
and players must call in advance to check for availability. A nominal green fee of £15  
will be charged for any such practice rounds. Please contact the Club for further details.

## **PRACTICE GROUND**

The practice ground will be available on the official practice day from 9am – 7pm and on  
Monday 27th July from 6.30am – 7pm (or the start of any play-off). Practice balls will be  
provided for players.

## **STARTING**

Play will start from the 1st tee. Players should report to the Starter on the tee **10  
minutes** prior to their starting time. Scorecards and pin positions will be distributed  
by the Starter.

## **YARDAGE BOOKS**

Yardage Books will be available from the Professional's shop.

## **DRIVING CLUBS**

Your attention is drawn to the condition of competition regarding Driving Clubs:

The driver a competitor carries must have a club head, identified by model and loft, that is named on the current List of Conforming Driver Heads issued by the R & A Rules Limited.

Note: Any individual driver on the List, if tested on the pendulum testing apparatus approved by the R & A Rules Limited, must not have a characteristic time greater than 257 microseconds. An updated list of Conforming Driver Heads is available on the R & A's website [www.randa.org](http://www.randa.org). This list is available in the LGU Championship Office.

***Penalty for breach of condition – Disqualification.***

## **CADDIES**

Players are responsible for the conduct of caddies at all times. Caddies must not wear spike-soled shoes. Local caddies may be reserved on a first come first served basis by calling the Club Pro on + 44 (0) 1253 736976.

## **QUALIFYING PLACES**

The number of qualifying places available through final qualifying will be posted prior to the commencement of play.

In the event of a tie for the last qualifying place (s), a sudden-death play-off will take place immediately following the conclusion of play. Likewise, this sudden-death play-off will be used to determine the 4 alternate spots.

Players' names will be called at the first tee approx. 10 minutes after the last players have recorded their scores. A player not present when called for the play-off will be disqualified from the play-off.

## **REGISTRATION FOR THE CHAMPIONSHIP**

All players qualifying through Final Qualifying for the Championship are reminded that they must register again for the in the Clubhouse at Royal Lytham & St. Annes Golf Club no later than 12.00 noon on Wednesday 29th July 2009.

## **DRESS CODE**

A reasonable standard of dress is required at all times. Please remove all headgear when in the clubhouse.

## **WITHDRAWALS**

### **Approaching from M6**

- At junction **32**, exit onto **M55** toward **Blackpool**
- At junction **4**, take the **A583** exit
- At the roundabout, take the **1st** exit onto **A583/Preston New Rd**
- At the roundabout, take the **3rd** exit onto **Lytham Saint Annes Way**
- Straight ahead at 1st roundabout
- At the roundabout, take the **3rd** exit onto **School Road**
- At traffic lights turn **left** at **B5261 onto Common Edge Road / Queensway**
- At next traffic lights go straight ahead, following B5261 onto **Heyhouses Lane**
- At next traffic lights turn **right** at **B5261 onto Blackpool Rd**
- Continue straight ahead at two mini roundabouts
- Turn **left**, after passing Fylde Rugby Club, at **Forest Drive** (immediately after zebra crossing)
- Turn **1st left** at **Oakwood Ave**
- Turn **1st right** into Fairhaven Golf Club
